1. Mulz W. Wilson, age 21, of 776 Grand Terrace, North Baldwin, NY

Arrested on 11/09/17 at 4:54 AM on State Route 79 in the Town of Richford for Driving While Intoxicated (Misdemeanor), Driving with .08 or more blood alcohol content, Moved from lane unsafely, Consumption of alcohol in a motor vehicle, Inadequate of no stop lamps, and refusal to take breath test.

These charges resulted from several 911 calls about Wilson's dangerous driving in the town of Richford. Wilson was issued appearance tickets to appear before Justice Peggy Anderson, Town of Richford Court, on 11/20/17.
