On Saturday October 24, 2020, the Tioga County Sheriff's Office partnered with the Trinity Casa House and participated in the semi-annual National Drug Take Back Event sponsored by the Drug Enforcement Administration. The event, which was held at 72 North Avenue, the Trinity Casa House, and at 41 N. Main Street in the Village of Spencer, was a success. The total amount of unused and unwanted medications collected in a four-hour period was approximately 160 pounds.

On Tuesday October 27, 2020, the Tioga County Sheriff's Office delivered approximately 760 pounds of unused and unwanted prescription and non-prescription medications to an incinerator facility in Syracuse for destruction. The total amount destroyed included items collected from the medication drop box at the Tioga County Sheriff's Office, as well as, drug take back events held by the above mentioned agencies since October 2019.
