- 1. Tamara E. Groover, age 31, of 1524 SR 79 Richford NY**
Arrested on 8/31/2019 at 12:30 AM for Harassment 2nd.

This charge resulted from the investigation of a harassment complaint. Groover was issued an appearance ticket and is scheduled to appear before Justice Dawn Olsen, Town of Berkshire Court, on 9/16/2019.

- 2. Bradley P. Snyder, age 30, of Germansville, PA**
Arrested on 8/30/2019 at AM for Fugitive from Justice.

This charge resulted from an arrest warrant that was issued out of Bradford County, Pennsylvania and a Probation/ Parole warrant that was issued out of Lehigh County, Pennsylvania. Snyder was arraigned before Justice Gary Dence, Town of Candor Court, and was remanded to the Tioga County Jail without bail.

These charges resulted from a motor vehicle accident that occurred on Waits Rd. in the Town of Owego. Kuhlman was issued appearance tickets to appear before Justice John Schumacher, Town of Owego Court, on 9/5/19.

- 4. Brandon Swansbrough, age 25 of 354 Straits Corners Rd., Candor, NY**
Arrested on 8/25/2019 at 9:05 PM for Unlawfully Fleeing an Officer in a Motor Vehicle, Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 7th, Speed in Zone, Driving Left of Pavement Markings, No License Plate Displayed, Driving on a Suspended Registration, Unregistered Motor Vehicle, Operating Motor Vehicle without Insurance, Improper/Switched License Plates, Unlicensed Operator, No Plate Lamps, Illegal Tire, Reckless Driving, Crossed over Hazard Markings, and Failed to Yield to Emergency Vehicle.

These charges resulted from a vehicle pursuit where Swansbrough failed to yield to emergency vehicles and attempted to flee. Swansbrough was arraigned before Justice Gary Dence, Town of Candor Court, and was remanded to the Tioga County Jail on \$10,000 bail or \$20,000 bond. Swansbrough is scheduled to reappear before Justice Dence on 9/9/2019.
